About JPI Climate

JPI Climate was launched in 2011 and involves **18 European countries** which are committed to coordinating their activities in the field of climate aligned under a common Strategic Research and Innovation Agenda. JPI Climate provides a platform for climate knowledge and decision support services for societal innovation and coordinates shared strategic research investments and provides climate knowledge and services for European and national climate strategies. It is Europe-focused, but its outputs have global reach and value. Its mission is to provide science to inform the implementation of the Paris Agreement and the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development, including its Sustainable Development Goals.

JPI Climate has so far mobilised more than 100 Mio EUR in research investments and has provided access to knowledge and expertise across Europe and beyond. This has been possible with the support of its member countries and co-funding opportunities by the European Commission (EC). At European level JPI Climate efforts are linked to other Joint Programming Initiatives such as JPI Oceans and JPI Urban Europe and other relevant programmes such as Copernicus and the EIT Climate-KIC. At global level collaboration is on-going with the Belmont Forum.

The "European Research Area for Climate Services" (ERA4CS) is JPI Climate's flagship project on climate services (in collaboration with the EC). ERA4CS is designed to boost the development of efficient climate services. It includes 45 partners from 18 European countries, with an overall budget of approximately 65 Mio EUR, which supports 26 projects.
