

TAKE OFF

Introduction and framework Internal/external analysis work

- EXTERNAL: analysis of changes, shocks and stress variations, risks, needs, etc.
- INTERNAL: methods and processes, aggregation of different projects and visions.



DIVE IN

Areas of relevance/intervention Annual/biennial reports

- macro-trends (social, demographic, environmental, economic, etc.)
- Update analysis to broaden the spectrum of issues and actions (e.g. pandemic, social fragility, inequalities, etc.).
- Possible drafting on the basis of stakeholder engagement processes (Fare Milano model).



TAKE ACTION

Objectives and actions Coordination between directorates


